Co-operation scheme for the payment of working capital grant to Women Co-operative Societies - Enhancement - Revision of Rules sanctioned Orders issued.

O R D E R

In the Government order read as first paper above, sanction was accorded for enhancing the maximum working capital grant from Government to eligible Womens Co-operative Society to Rs. 50,000/- (Rupees fifty thousand only)

2. In the letter read as second paper above the Registrar of Co-operative Societies has informed that the amount of Rs. 50,000/- is quite inadequate to start viable ventures that will give maximum employment to its members and requested for the enhancement of the limit from the present 50,000/- to Rs. 1,00,000/-. The Registrar of Co-operative Societies has further informed that money value has eroded and the cost of materials and equipments has increased manifold.

3. Government have examined the matter in details and accepting the recommendation of the Registrar of Co-operative Societies are pleased to accord sanction enhancing the maximum limit fixed for granting working capital grant to the Mahila Co-operative Societies to Rs.1,00,000/ - (Rupees one lakh only). Rule 2 (ii) of the "Rules for the payment of working capital grant to Mahila Co-operative Societies, 1985" is accordingly amended as follows, all other conditions remaining the same.



Rule 2 (ii) of the "Rules for the payment of working capital grant to Mahila Co-operative Societies, 1985" is accordingly amended as follows, all other conditions remaining the same.

Rules for the payment of Working Capital Grant to Mahila Co-operative Societies

1. These rules shall be called "The Rules for grant of Working Capital Grant to Mahila Co-operative Societies, 1985".
2. All Registered Mahila Co-operative Societies will be eligible for assistance under these rules subject to the following conditions:-
 - i. The society shall be one selected for the payment of grant by the Registrar of Co-operative Societies.
 - ii. Any one Mahila Co-operative Societies selected will be eligible for a working capital grant not exceeding Rs.1, 00,000/-(Rupees One Lakh only).
3. Every application for assistance under these rules shall be submitted in Form 'A' appended to these Rules. True Copies of the resolution of the Board of Directors requesting for assistance under these rules, specifying the amount of assistance is required, should be attached in Triplicate to the application form.
4. The working capital grant will be sanctioned by the Joint Registrar of the District concerned subject to budget provision and the amount placed at his disposal.
5. The society receiving assistance under these rules shall execute a bond in favour of Governor of Kerala in Form 'B' appended to these rules.
6. The bill for the working capital grant shall be drawn by the society in a bill for miscellaneous payments duly countersigned by the Joint Registrar of the District concerned. The amount of Working Capital grant thus drawn shall be deposited in a Co-operative bank or Government Treasury Savings Bank account in the name of the Society and shall be operated with the permission of the Joint Registrar and utilized for the purpose for which it was sanctioned.
7. The amount of working capital grant received under the rules shall be entered in the Books of accounts of the society and all the records of accounts, stock books, etc of the society shall be open for inspection at any time by the officers of the Department.
8. The society shall furnish the Utilisation Certificate within a period of three months from the date of withdrawal of the amount from the Treasury/Bank.
9. On Breach of any of the conditions or misuse of grants, the amount of grant sanctioned to the society shall be recovered from the society in lump under the provisions of the Revenue Recovery Act for the time being in force or in such other manner as may be decided by the Registrar of Co-operative Societies.
10. Government may by order for reasons to be recorded in writing exempt any society from any of the provision contained in these rules.

which shall form part of this deed as if incorporated herein) the Registrar of Co-
Operative Societies has on behalf of the Government as per his order

letter of sanction" which shall also form an integral part of these presents and a copy
whereof is annexed hereto as Annexure 'A')agreed to make it in favour of the
obligors for the purpose of working Capital grant of Rs.....

contained in the letter of sanction, the Rules and also subject to the terms and
conditions herein contained to which the obligors have agreed.

Now the conditions of the above written bond or obligation is such that if the
obligors shall perform all the terms and conditions contained in the letter of sanction
and the Rules as amended from time to time or these herein contained or such other

rules as may be framed hereinafter in substitution for the rules, then the above written bond or obligation shall be void and of no effect, otherwise the same shall be and remain in full force and effect.

Provided always that if the obligors have not utilised all or any portion of the amount of Grant for the purpose for which it was granted in the event of their failing to comply with all or any of the terms and conditions under which the grant was sanctioned or the terms and conditions contained in the letter of sanction or the Rules as amended from time to time or those herein after contained then the entire amount of grant with interest due thereof as may be prescribed by the Registrar of Co-operative Societies in this behalf shall become immediately payable in a lump and the obligors shall pay the same. If the obligors fail to pay the amount when demanded, the Registrar of Co-operative Societies for and on behalf the Government may recover the same from the obligors in the manner herein provided.

The obligors hereby further agree that all sums found due to the Government under or by virtue of this bond shall be recoverable from the obligors and their properties both movable and immovable under the provisions of the Revenue Recovery Act for the time being in force as though such sums are arrears of land revenue due on land and in such other manner as the government may deem fit.
